

FLOWER DESIGN SCHEDULE FOR NOVEMBER

- Year Theme: "Let's Dance"
Month Theme: Texas Two Step
Tea Table: Carol Callahan
Designer's Choice of plant material
- Provisional: Traditional Right or Left Angle Design, *Handbook*, pp. 182-183. Allotted space 14" wide x 12" deep, on the kitchen shelf, 43" from the floor.
- Novice: Traditional Plaque Design, *Handbook*, p. 206. On a panel provided by the exhibitor not to exceed 16" wide x 20" tall. Staged on table 30" from floor in front of footed backboard 24" wide x 36" tall, for support, provided by committee.
- Intermediate: Traditional Crescent Line Design, see *Handbook*, p. 182. Allotted space 24" wide x 24" deep. Staged on a table 30" from the floor. Underlay required.
- Advanced II: Stretch Design, *Handbook*, p. 202. Staged on a table on a stage 42" from floor in front of a back board panel 36" high x 24" wide provided by committee. Exhibitor must cover backboard and provide underlay.
- Advanced I: Reflective Design, *Handbook*, p. 207. Staged on a round pedestal 42" high with a 15" round black top. Underlay optional.
- Advanced Plus: Parallel Design, *Handbook*, p. 206. Staged on a table on a stage 42" from the floor, allotted space 24" wide x 24" wide. Underlay optional.
- Trial Run: Critiqued only, all entries welcome.
- Invitational: Deborah Moran

HORTICULTURE SCHEDULE FOR NOVEMBER

- Year Theme: "Let's Dance"
Phone or email Jacklyn Kling by NOVEMBER 13, to pre-register entries. Entries are due in the Garden Room between 8 and 9 am on MONDAY, NOVEMBER 14. Entries must be cleaned, conditioned, and identified by *genus* and *species*, *variety* or *cultivar*, and *common name*.
- Class 1. Needled Evergreen branches, stems NOT to exceed 30 inches and MUST have several nodes
- Class 2. Broadleaf evergreen branches, stems NOT to exceed 30 inches and MUST have several nodes
- Class 3. Cacti and Succulents
- Class 4. Santipauli: African Violets
- Class 5. Container grown foliage plant, container diameter NOT to exceed 8 inches
- Class 6. Container grown flowering plant, container diameter NOT to exceed 8 inches
