Designer's Choice of plant material
- Provisional: Traditional Vertical Line Design, see *Handbook*, p. 182.
Allotted space 14" wide x 12" deep, staged on kitchen shelf 43" from the floor.
- Novice: Traditional Line Mass Design, see *Handbook*, p. 182.
Staged on a table 30" from the floor. Exhibitor must provide underlay.
- Intermediate: Any Traditional Design, staged using a 42" tall black square pedestal with a 14" black top provided by committee. Underlay optional.
- Advanced II: A Design, freedom of style using **Monochromatic** colors see *Handbook*, pp. 166 and 338. Staged on a table on a stage 42" from floor in front of a backboard panel 36" high x 24" wide provided by committee. Exhibitor must cover backboard and provide underlay.
- Advanced I: A Design, freedom of style using **Analogous** colors, see *Handbook*, pp. 166 and 330. Staged on a table on a stage 42" from floor in front of a backboard panel 36" high x 24" wide provided by committee. Exhibitor must cover backboard and provide underlay.
- Advanced Plus: A Design, freedom of style using **Complementary** Color harmony, see *Handbook*, pp. 166-167 and 332. Staged on a table on a stage 42" from floor in front of a backboard panel 36" high x 24" wide provided by committee. Exhibitor must cover backboard and provide underlay.
- Trial Run: Critiqued only, all entries welcome.

HORTICULTURE SCHEDULE FOR OCTOBER

- Year Theme: "Let's Dance"
Phone or email Jacklyn Kling by 9 p.m. OCTOBER 23, to pre-register entries. Entries are due in the Garden Club Room between 8 and 9 am on MONDAY, OCTOBER 24. Entries must be cleaned, conditioned, and identified by *genus* and *species*, *variety* or *cultivar*, and *common name*.
- Class 1. Annuals-One stem for a large specimen; three stems for small
Class 2. Perennials-One stem for a large specimen; three stems for small
Class 3. Ornamental Grass Not to exceed 30" in length
Class 4. Bulbs, corms, and tubers
Class 5. Roses
Class 6. Vegetables
Class 7. Autumn foliage Not to exceed 30" in length
Class 8. Any other worthy specimen. May be container grown, pot not to exceed 6 inches in diameter
Class 9. Herbs
