Entries must be **cleaned, conditioned, and identified by genus, species, variety or cultivar, and commons name.** Please see *Handbook for Flower Shows*, pages 49 to 61. PROVISIONALS NEED TO FILL OUT BOTH AN ENTRY CARD AND A 3 X 5 CARD.

- Class 1 Annuals: 1 stem for a large specimen; 3 stems for small
- Class 2 Perennials: 1 stem for a large specimen; 3 stems for small
- Class 3 Ornamental Grass, NOT to exceed 30" in length
- Class 4 Bulbs, corms, and tubers
- Class 5 Roses, one stem or a progression of blooms*
- Class 6 Vegetables
- Class 7 Herbs*
- Class 8 Autumn foliage, NOT to exceed 30" in length
- Class 9 Any other worthy specimen, may be container grown, pot not to exceed 6" in diameter
