**There will be 2 Awards this month:**

**The Amy Hatrak Herb Award and The Barbara Meyer Rose Award**

- Class 1 Annuals – 1 stem for large specimen; 3 stems for small
- Class 2 Perennials – 1 stem for large specimen; 3 stems for small
- Class 3 Ornamental Grass – NOT to exceed 30” in length (may be entered in Botanical Arts if additional height is necessary)
- Class 4 Bulbs, corms and tubers
- Class 5 Roses – (eligible for The Barbara Meyer Rose Award)
- Class 6 Vegetables and Herbs
- Class 7 A collection of 5 different herbs (eligible for The Amy Hatrak Herb Award ***counts as one submission***)
- Class 8 Any other worthy specimen, may be container grown, pot NOT to exceed 6” in diameter.
