Botanical Arts Photography Rules

- 1. Photos must be taken by the Exhibitor, film or digital, and must not have been previously entered in an NGC Flower Show.
- 2. Photos are to be mounted in a white, 11" x 14" mat with window (image) size of 8" x 10". Mats must be labeled on the back with Exhibitor's name. A clear acetate sleeve will be provided.
- 3. Photo orientation may be vertical or horizontal. Indicate the top of the photo on the back of the mat.
- 4. Judging will be based on the Photography Scale of Points, *Handbook for Flower Shows*, p. 131. Entries by Provisionals will be critiqued only.
- 5. Each Exhibitor may enter only one photograph and must indicate whether it's for Class 1 or Class 2 at time of registration.
- 6. Photographs are to be delivered during the week prior to the Competition. Date, time, and delivery location will be emailed to Exhibitors.

Class 1 "The Winter Landscape"

A landscape or panoramic photo. Color or black+white.

Class 2 "Shoot Outside the Box"

A photo showing a close-up or unique perspective of a flower or other part of a plant. Strive to create an abstract or mysterious image. Color or black+white.
