FLOWER DESIGN DIVISION

Designer's Choice of Plant material

- Provisional: An American Traditional Design, choose Line or Mass, see *Handbook* pages 70-71. Allotted space 14" wide x 12" deep. Staged on a table 30" from the floor. Table covered with ivory cloth. Wall is sage green. Underlay required.
- Novice: A Design, Freedom of Style. Allotted space 20" wide x 18" deep. Staged on a table 30" from the floor. Table covered with ivory cloth. Wall is sage green. Staging panel and underlay optional.
- Intermediate: A Creative Design using complementary colors, see *Handbook* page 65. Allotted space 20" wide x 18" deep. Staged on a table 30" from the floor. Table covered with ivory cloth. Wall is sage green. Staging panel and underlay required.
- Advanced: A Creative Design using analogous colors, see *Handbook* page 65. Staged on a round black pedestal 42" tall with a 14" square black top. Wall is sage green. Underlay optional.
- Advanced+: A Creative Design using monochromatic colors, see *Handbook* page 65. Staged on a round black pedestal 36" tall with a 14" square black top. Wall is sage green. Underlay optional.

BOTANICAL ARTS DIVISION

A **Collage**, see *Handbook* page 93.

Staged on a board not to exceed 16"x 20". Can be shown in either a horizontal or vertical position on an easel provided by the Committee. Staged on a table 30" from the floor and covered with ivory cloth. All surfaces should be covered or painted, freedom of components, some plant material must be included.

Open to Novice, Intermediate, Advanced, and Advanced+.
