- Class 1 Annuals – One stem for a large specimen; three stems for small
- Class 2 Perennials – One stem for a large specimen; three stems for small
- Class 3 Ornamental Grass - NOT to exceed 30" in length
- Class 4 Bulbs, corms, and tubers
- Class 5 Roses – 1 stem or progression of blooms*
- Class 6 Vegetables
- Class 7 Autumn Foliage not to exceed 30" (may be entered in Botanical Arts if additional height is necessary)
- Class 8 Herbs**
- Class 9 Any other worthy specimen, may be container grown, pot not to exceed 6 inches" in diameter
